

New Beginnings

We supported **96** new clients virtually or via the telephone

We registered **56** families to the Healthy Holidays program throughout the summer of 2020

26 clients attended the New Beginnings Coffee morning with activities including a family quiz

22 clients attended the New Beginnings Women's Empowerment workshop

13 children participated in the Sheffield Healthy Holiday Activities and Food Consultation Programme 2021

We distributed Easter activity packs to **55** children

We distributed spring half-term activity packs to **70** children

We referred **33** families to St Mary's Supermarket for food hampers

In December, we provided Christmas hampers to over **100** refugee and Asylum seeker families that were struggling financially and would have otherwise not have been able to afford a proper Christmas

We also provided Christmas gifts to **95** children through donations by Hallam FM

Volunteer Centre

We delivered monthly '**Introduction to Volunteering'** training sessions to **59** clients through our collaboration with British Red Cross Rotherham

In 2021, 211 organisations advertised for volunteer roles through our website 1002 volunteers registered on the website for new opportunities

256 people were helped with their volunteering section

Payroll Services

We delivered payroll services to **122** charity and community groups providing **980** payslips per month by March 2021

Race and Governance

153 people attended the VAS Race and Governance event on increasing diversity on boards within the city.

SPRING Project

We supported **353** new refugees

Supporting Organisations

We supported **280** community groups supported in one or more area of operation

139 community groups were supported with skills to recruit and manage volunteers

We worked with **141** groups, successfully targeting under represented and lower income groups

Lunch Clubs

44 lunch clubs received support to enhance how they work

We consulted **16** lunch clubs to identify needs and explore ways of helping clubs to get support out to their isolated members while lunch clubs were unable to operate

24 lunch clubs regularly attend our monthly information and resources zoom meeting

Social Prescribing

Our Covid-19 network has grown to **55** organisations

52 members have signed up for the Sheffield Autism Partnership Network

We supported **16** number of new projects in the Empowered community's programme

We have **16** members of the social prescribing network

Healthwatch Sheffield

Healthwatch Sheffield spoke to **2,111** people about their experiences of health and social care

Healthwatch Sheffield provided advice and information to **252** people

Healthwatch Sheffield heard from **567** people about their experiences of health, care, and support services

during the COVID-19 pandemic

Sheffield Businesses Together

Sheffield Businesses Together delivered **51** projects to **46+** charities in Sheffield

Sheffield Businesses Together gave **£245,644** total value of hours and money and in-kind donations to 50+ charities across Sheffield City Region

Sheffield Business Together led a collaborative food poverty campaign securing **£132k** of cash & donations of food

Sheffield Business Together has been able to distribute of **1,000+** children's books, age 3-7 years old, across 15 different charities in Sheffield

Professional Services

We completed **110** accounts preparations & independent examinations, & also completed **33** corporation tax returns ensuring all of our clients met the statutory filing requirements for Companies House, Charity Commission and HMRC
